Booking Policy

- Times and Dates of classes may be subject to change. All classes are offered in good faith. A minimum class size must be reached before any class can go ahead. Please check with the shop 7 days before the class is due to start. It is very important to us that you do not invest a lot of money in class supplies until we are sure that the class will go ahead.
- Unless otherwise stated, in any classes using sewing machines, it is assumed you have a working knowledge of your own machine and all the parts required for that class. Please check that you have the power cords when you pack.
- A minimum deposit of \$20 is required when booking a class. This will be refunded or transferred if the class cannot go ahead. Deposits may be refunded if you cancel your booking with at least 10 days notice. Deposits cannot be transferred or refunded if you cancel a booking within this period as we are committed to run the class for others who have already bought their supplies and teachers that have been prebooked.
